Division 1. CUT FLOWERS

Flowers must be grown by the Exhibitor.

Roses

1. One stem, H.T. Rose Bud, up to 2 petals unfurled or 25% open.
2. One stem, H.T. Rose. May be wired.
3. One stem or cut of any Floribunda or Polyanthus variety.
4. One stem or cut of mini-Rose.
5. One stem or cut of English, Heritage or Shrub Rose.
6. Three stems of Roses of one variety, any type, 3 stages of opening, in one vessel.
7. Three stems of different Roses, same stage of opening, in one vessel.
8. Container of mixed Roses, minimum of 5 stems and/cuts, minimum of 3 different

Gerberas

9. Gerbera, old-fashioned Single, one.
10. Gerbera, old-fashioned S/Double or Double, one.
11. Gerbera, Large Double, one.
12. Gerbera, any other Hybrid type, one.

STEM: One stem with no side buds, foliage allowed

CUT: Side blooms and buds, foliage and branching allowed.

STEM COUNT: As from the top of the vessel.
