Flowers must have been grown by the Exhibitor.

Roses

- 1. Rose Bud, any variety, one stem, Up to 25% open.
- 2. Rose, any Large flowered variety, one stem.
- 3. Rose, Any Multi-flowered variety, one cut.
- 4. Mini Rose, one stem or cut.
- 5. Roses of one variety, any type, 3 stems in 3 stages of opening, in one vessel.
- Roses, any kinds, same or different, 3 stems or cuts, same stages of opening, in one vessel.
 SPECIAL PRIZE for Most Perfumed Rose.

- 7. Gerbera, old-fashioned Single, one.
- 8. Gerbera, old-fashioned S/Double Or Double, one.
